Purpose:

To provide (3) Scholarships for those who intend to further their education at any college or university, with a preference given to trade or technical fields of study in an Agriculture program. Examples of which include Natural resources, and Range management. But not limited to other programs of study including Farrier Science, Welding, Meat Processing, or obtaining a Commercial Drivers License.

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Applicant must be between the ages of 17 and 25.
2. Completed application form typed.
3. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average, ACT and/or SAT scores, and a class standing/rank.
4. Brief explanation of student involvement in activities applicant has been involved in.
5. What are the applicant's future plans in pursuing further educational opportunities.
6. What awards or special recognition applicant has received.
7. List of specific ways applicant has assisted in their community through volunteerism, etc.
8. List of scholarships and any financial assistance received or will receive.
9. Description of agricultural background.
10. What agricultural curriculum applicant plans to follow.
11. Applicant's work experience.

NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in a program of study.
